Our team and board has recently been in contact with City officials regarding updates on how to best handle public safety concerns or incidents so downtown's leaders are prepared:

### **Graffiti/Property Damage**

The GBPD keeps a graffiti database to track the source of these incidents. Officer Warych wants to be updated even if you are immediately removing/painting over the graffiti. We ask that you contact him with a photo/address/time of incident if this should occur.

### **Homelessness/Vagrancy**

Community Officer Nate Allen is a contact for personal outreach for any homeless individuals you may encounter or see outside a business or building. You can also contact the non-emergency line at (920) 448-3200. They want to hear about any/all incidents in order to most effectively advocate for more resources towards this issue. If you see someone in your building upon entering, they enter and refuse to leave, or is making you uncomfortable in any way, call 911 immediately. Even if non-threatening, the police want to be made aware of anyone unlawfully entering a premises.
